

California Targeted Districts

In November, as California goes, so goes the House. While Democrats in many other states will be playing defense, in California we can play offense, significantly increase the size of CA's House delegation, and offset losses elsewhere. Redistricting has improved our chances to defeat *at least* 3 incumbent Republicans, and two others are vulnerable. And of course we need to defend a few Democratic incumbents in competitive districts.

Below are current CA postcard projects:

CA-13 Open Seat. This is a lean Democratic area in the Central Valley, but is likely to be hotly contested in November.

CA-22 Tossup district. Defeat David Valadao, who in 2020 won by < 1%, and redistricting has put him in a district that leans more Democratic

CA-27 Tossup district. Defeat Republican Mike Garcia, who won in 2020 by only 300+ votes.

CA-47 Reelect Katie Porter in her new Orange County district.

CA-49 Reelect Mike Levin in his San Diego and Orange County based seat.

CA-09 Reelect Josh Harder in his new district. **Spanish script.** Write to Democrats who have requested ballots in Spanish.

Recipients are registered Democrats who sometimes skip midterm elections. Script is similar for all districts: praises Biden & Democrats for progress made, and informs voters that all CA Republicans voted against the bills that made progress possible. All are mail as completed, within 2 weeks of receiving addresses.
